



## Flag of Cambodia

Adopted on 1993 (previously used 1948-1970).

Three horizontal bands of blue, red (double width) and blue, with a depiction of Angkor Wat in white centered on the red band. Since around 1850, the Cambodian flag has featured a depiction of Angkor Wat in the center.

It was used until October 9, 1970, when a new flag was introduced for Lon Nol's Khmer Republic that lasted until the takeover of the Khmer Rouge in 1975.
